Roundup: Petoskey wins TC West Invite

St. Francis tennis places third

TRAVERSE CITY -- Led by Joey Garber's 72 in cold and windy conditions, Petoskey won Saturday's Traverse City West Invite at The Crown.

The Northmen had 325 for first, followed by Rockford (326), TC West (329), Charlevoix (333), Cadillac (334), TC Central (335) and Gaylord (341).

Garber was medalist with 72 while Central's Patrick Colburn was second with 75. Tied for third at 79 were Petoskey's Jamie Braddock, West's Gates Muller, Rockford's Trent Davison and Cadillac's Josh Platko. Thomas Rich from Charlevoix and Evan Miller from St. Francis shot 80 to tie for sixth. Sam Gallup of Rockford tied for 9th with an 81.

Homeschooler Nikolaj Brons-Piche shot 81 to tie for ninth. He also carded a hole-in-one on the 16th.

West had an 82 from Ian Davis while Chris Dienes and Kevin Gaston each shot 84. The Titans had an 82 from Zack Smith, an 84 from Trevor Mattis and a 94 from Winton Munch. St. Francis had Miller's 80, an 89 from Mike Bork, a 91 from Stefan Schofield and Kolter Hornyak's 100.

TC West's JV scores included Graeme Placek's 83, Andrew Hartman's 87, a 90 from Eric Charters, Payden Myers and Ryan Sievers while Sam Murray shot 92.
